North Tahoe Public Utility District Seeks New Members for the Recreation and Parks Commission

(Tahoe Vista, California) - The North Tahoe Public Utility District (NTPUD) is seeking interested people for volunteer positions on the District's Recreation and Parks Commission. Two adult seats and two youth seats are open to be filled.


The Commission is currently focusing on the implementation and outreach for the new Friends of the Park Fund. This fund is looking to raise money for a number of projects in the North Tahoe Regional Park such as new playground equipment, restoration of the Nature Trail, Par Course and Ramada, and a host of other projects. Community involvement is extremely important! The Commission meets monthly and meetings last approximately two to three hours. The Commissioners are also asked for additional time commitments for special events, e.g. Pancake Breakfast or other community events, to share information on the Friends of the Park Fund and other Commission activities.

The Recreation and Parks Commission is an advisory commission to the NTPUD Board of Directors on matters of Recreation and Parks. The Commission is a liaison between the NTPUD Board and the community and consists of five (5) adult members and two (2) student

members. All Commissioners must be residents of the District and the student members must be full-time, 11th or 12th grade students in good standing. Applicants must fill out an application. All applications will be submitted to the NTPUD Board of Directors for consideration. Two student seats will be filled.
